## How to Connect to the Courthouse Public Network with a Network Cable

Network cables are located at counsel tables. Plug in the end of the network cable into the laptop (see picture below). No other configuration is required.



# **How to Connect to the Courthouse Public Network (Wi-Fi)**

### **To Connect:**

Click on "Wi-Fi", the button will change to "On".



Click Wi-Fi



You should see the list of available W1-F1 networks. Select Courts Public



Checkoff "Connect automatically" and select the Connect button


Enter the Pin Code (no spaces) and select Continue.

The public facing home page for the Alberta Courts website will open.






When connected the W1-F1 network dialog box should appear as follows.




### **To Disconnect:**
