1. You shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour.
2. You shall appear before the court when required to do so.
3. You shall remain within the Province of Alberta unless you have written permission from your bail supervisor or the court to leave the Province of Alberta.
4. You shall abide by all rules of the household provided to you in writing. [Youth]
5. You shall report in person to a bail supervisor within _____ working day(s) of release, and thereafter as required and in the manner directed by your supervisor.
6. You shall report _____ to the _____ RCMP detachment each _____
Commencing _____ 20_____, between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:00 pm and notify the
_____ RCMP Detachment of your current address and any change of address thereafter.
7. You shall notify your bail supervisor, in advance, of any change of name, address, or employment.
8. You shall reside at a residence approved of, in writing, by your bail supervisor.
9. You shall abide by a curfew and remain in your residence between the hours of _____

You shall present yourself at the door of your residence to your supervisor or to any peace officer who attends in order to verify compliance with this term.

10. You shall have no contact or communication, directly or indirectly, with: _____

a) Except for necessary court attendances or in the presence of legal counsel.
b) Access to the children shall be arranged through a mutually agreeable third party or as directed by the court.

11. You shall not attend at or within a _____ meter/block radius of _____

a) Except on one occasion in the company of a _____ member to collect personal belongings.
12. You shall refrain from the purchase, possession, use or consumption of alcohol, other intoxicating substances, or any non-prescribed illegal drugs.
a) You shall not attend or enter any licensed premise of which its primary business is the sale of alcohol.
13. You shall not be found in possession of any weapons, edged or otherwise.
14. You shall not be found in possession of any firearms, ammunition, explosives or any other type of weapon whatsoever and you shall surrender any firearms, ammunition, explosives or any other type of weapon currently within your possession to the _____ Police Service or _____ RCMP Detachment within 24 hours of your release.
15. You shall not be found in the possession of a cell phone, pager or other portable hand-held electronic communication device.
Exceptions: _____
16. You shall surrender your passport or other travel documents to the clerk of the Provincial Court of Alberta within 24 hours of release or provide evidence under oath that you do not possess a passport or other travel documents.
17. You shall carry a copy of your release documents with you at all times when outside of your residence and produce them to a Peace Officer upon request.
18. You shall not be found sitting behind the steering wheel of any motor vehicle in Alberta.
a) You shall not be found in any private motor vehicle in Alberta unless the registered owner is present.
