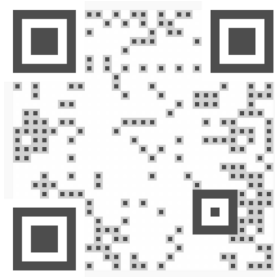

- To speak with Duty Counsel, you need to phone or sign in to Webex prior to Court commencing.
- Duty Counsel are lawyers who provide free services to assist people without a lawyer, who are appearing in Docket Court
- The main purpose of Duty Counsel is to give you a chance to speak to a lawyer before you appear in Court.
- Docket Court is usually a very busy courtroom. It is a place where a Judge has a brief opportunity to talk about each matter that is scheduled.
- If you have an agreement the Judge can hear the agreement and can make your agreement into a Court Order.
- If you do not have an agreement, the Judge will need to know if you plan to hire a lawyer, or attend mediation or if you want to attend a hearing or trial before a Judge.
