Medicine Hat Child Enhancement Court Update

All Child Enhancement docket court matters will continue to be conducted remotely unless otherwise authorized by the Court.

Effective **immediately**, Child Enhancement docket court may be accessed by Webex video for all **lawyers**, and **caseworkers** designated to appear on behalf of a child protection agency. These participants will be expected to connect to the virtual courtroom through Webex video as opposed to telephone unless they are unable to access video.

Parties to the proceedings will be connected through the Webex telephone system by the courtroom clerk who will contact the party at the telephone number they have provided.

Webex Video: The Clerk will open the virtual courtroom session no later than 9:20 a.m. Once the Clerk opens this session you will be able to connect to the courtroom.

Please reference the Provincial Court of Alberta Conduct Guide for Remote Appearances posted on the Alberta Courts website. We strongly encourage use of a headset with a microphone to ensure adequate sound quality.
