Scheduled Disposition Hearings -307

Courtroom 307 is designated for scheduled disposition hearings. This Court has a morning session, starting at 9:30 a.m., and an afternoon session that begins at 2:00 p.m.

Dispositions that proceed in this court will have an agreement as between the Crown and the accused on both the charges where guilty pleas will be made and on the facts in support of those charges. If these matters are not agreed, and especially where evidence may need to be called to settle those differences, a separate hearing should be booked for half a day or longer through CMO.

Accused persons are expected to appear in person. When they are in custody direction should be sought at the time the disposition is booked through any docket court indicating that a Judge's Order or CCTV appearance is authorized. Where the disposition is contested or is expected to be lengthy, an in-person appearance is preferred.

Counsel are expected to appear in person at disposition hearings. Exceptional requests for remote appearance are governed by the **Remote Appearance Practice Note PN 2022 R1**.
